


Ford PI Utility Cargo Barrier 2011-2019





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INSTALLATION GUIDE

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YOU WILL NEED:

A partner to assist Installation guide Socket Wrench Set Drill with 7/16 drill bit Impact Utility Knife Ratchet Center punch Masking tape Panel tools/Screwdriver Cutters

PARTS LIST

A. Passenger Side Cargo Barrier Bracket
B. Driver Side Cargo Barrier Bracket
C. Cargo Barrier
D. Floor Braces
E. Pre-Slit Foam
F. Hardware and Installation Guide

There was no picture for this guide either on the existing guide or taken during our time together.

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INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS DO NOT TIGHTEN ANY BOLTS UNTIL ASSEMBLY IS COMPLETE!

- 1. Install cargo barrier bracket **loosely** to the cargo barrier passenger side. The Custom Cage logo on cargo barrier faces the front of vehicle.
- 2. Install cargo barrier bracket **loosely** to the cargo barrier driver side.
- 3. Place cargo barrier inside rear of vehicle and hold to ceiling and against rear seat backs.
- 4. Mark the plastic moldings on both sides where the brackets will attach.
- Remove cargo barrier and set aside. Remove the lower plastic from the driver's side rear and door area. Remove the upper molding using a 7mm socket to remove 1 bolt. Molding will pull out from the bottom and unlock from the headliner.
- 6. Install driver side inner molding bracket with 1" tap screw. Be sure to line up the mark on molding and the bracket.
- 7. Reinstall the upper molding first, then the lower plastic.
- 8. With a 7/16 drill bit, drill out the holes you marked for the side brackets.
- Install cargo barrier with tap screws. Do not overtighten.
 Use Caution: Passenger/prisoner side has very thin metal behind the plastic. Be careful!
- 10. Attach the floor braces to the cargo barrier and tap screw to the floor.
